The Saint-Denis market, guaranteed atmosphere.

The largest market in Ile-de-France and surely one of the liveliest, the downtown Saint-Denis market takes place three times a week. To get a feel for its soul, the simplest way is to visit the stand of the Pinard brothers, Breton farmers for three generations. Their apples and pears were first grown in the neighboring town of Villetaneuse before the family moved to the nearby Val d'Oise.

La Parcelle, a very lively garden.

Going up the Saint-Denis canal from the Stade de France, La Parcelle is a cultural garden located at Porte d'Aubervilliers, in the cocoon that is 19M, the Chanel manufacture that has brought together 12 art houses and their 700 artisans since 2022. In the heart of La Parcelle, there is a children's playground, a café, art installations, but also workshops and artistic activities, particularly led by Poush, a creation and artistic dissemination place established in Aubervilliers.

Hopscotch at Georges-Valbon.

If you want to escape the Olympic hustle and bustle, there's nothing better than changing the scenery by joining the sheepfold of the Georges-Valbon Departmental Park in La Courneuve. Managed by the Clinamen association, this sheepfold oversees a flock of about a hundred sheep that you can regularly accompany in their grazing areas spread over more than 400 hectares of this Central Park made in Seine-Saint-Denis, as well as on the campus of Paris-13 University in Villetaneuse.

Saint-Ouen, so Brazil!

In Saint-Ouen, they love Brazil and make it known by displaying a mural on a building on Passage des Boute-en-train in honor of Doctor Socrates, created by Brazilian artist RafaMon. This installation also echoes the inauguration of a Socratès street in the Athletes' Village and especially the fact that the city of Saint-Ouen will host the training of the Brazilian delegation during the 2024 Olympics.
