The top 3 best addresses in Plaine Commune for traveling differently and inexpensively right at the end of your street. No need for a plane, and a carbon footprint that lightens even when moving at 299,792,458 meters per second in Aubervilliers.

A journey at the speed of light

In Aubervilliers, the Cherqui Foundation is a true museum housing a private collection of 5,000 optical and kinetic artworks in a hangar that is increasingly opening to the general public. Mathias Chetrit, a designer of luminous works and grandson of the collector Jean Cherqui, organizes guided tours through his grandfather's vast collection. In this foundation, you can press buttons or even touch artworks to better understand various optical phenomena.

Kayaking on the Seine

Among the participants of the annual event "Tour of Île-Saint-Denis by Kayak and Anything that Floats," the Canoe-Kayak Club of Gennevilliers (92) frequently ventures into Seine-Saint-Denis and onto the Seine, inviting you to join their training sessions and club outings from the Pont d'Epinay-sur-Seine. It's a great way to spot some rare bird species nesting between Île-Saint-Denis and the banks of Épinay.

Turkey at your fingertips

In Saint-Ouen-sur-Seine, at the restaurant "O Dürüm," a Red Star supporter's scarf indicates that this kebab specialist also sells his Turkish sandwiches at the nearby Stade Bauer on match days. Otherwise, in his restaurant at 32 Boulevard Jean-Jaurès, Turan Dizlek brings more than two decades of master kebab-making experience to delight your taste buds. This skill earned him the title of best kebab in the Île-de-France region in 2022 by the specialized magazine "C'est meilleur quand c'est bon."
