SYNOPSIS

Discover the Garden Cities by Bike

Enjoy a scenic bike ride through the Plaine Commune area to connect the garden cities via a route starting in Villetaneuse, with stops in Pierrefitte-sur-Seine, Stains, and a grand finale in Georges-Valbon Park in La Courneuve. Along the way, discover the very sixties architecture of Paris-XIII University in Villetaneuse and the tranquility of the Joncherolles landscaped cemetery. Also, explore the National Archives site in Pierrefitte.

5km of Urban and Contemporary Art in the Open Air

By bike, on foot, on rollerblades, with family, alone, or with friends... Traverse the 5 kilometers along the Canal Saint-Denis, from La Villette to the Stade de France, the longest open-air art route!
