Through various calls for projects, Plaine Commune is committed to supporting local actors who bring forth meaningful initiatives aligned with the public policies developed daily. "Fabriques d'avenirs" thus supports concrete projects in favor of the ecological transition. "Interfaces!" supported cultural and artistic projects this year in an Olympic version. Finally, the call for projects dedicated to the Social and Solidarity Economy was themed in 2024 as a special edition for the Paris Games.

L'Autre champ, the culture of social connection. Based in Villetaneuse, the association "L'Autre champ" is active at home but also throughout Seine-Saint-Denis, promoting quality cinema to a broad audience. It also offers workshops on audiovisual practices and support for content creation for all audiences. Its other field of action focuses on alternative gardening and agrobiological practices, aiming to enhance natural spaces in hyperurbanized areas and make them accessible for agricultural practices to the residents. Goal: fostering social connection.

La Fabrique Pointcarré, the Dionysian DIY. An integration workshop located in Saint-Denis, La Fabrique Pointcarré organized a 24-hour circular design hackathon at the end of 2023, aiming to repurpose sports waste. Participants imagined, created, and prototyped new objects using the Fabrique's machines and tools. Winner: a seesaw stool assembled with relay batons used in athletics championships.

An ethical fashion triathlon on the ice rink of Saint-Ouen. Winner of the Interfaces call for projects in 2024, the association Universal Love is dedicated to promoting fashion engaged in best practices, respecting humans throughout the garment manufacturing chain and the environment through the use of natural materials or those with minimal environmental impact. In this spirit, since 2021, it has launched the "Triathlon of Ethical Fashion," three events centered around fashion, sports, recycling, and education, bringing together over 1000 students. Their creations can be discovered at the Saint-Ouen ice rink from July 15 to August 15, 2024.
